Lunchbox theatre hits *Whole in One*

To putt or not to putt?

Lunchbox Theatre's new production *A Whole in One* is a comedy that scores with both those who like to walk the links and those who don't.

Micheal (Trevor Leigh) is a golfer, whose desire for a hole-in-one is stronger than that for his wife, Sharon (Barbara Gates Wilson).

Paul McLaughlin's witty and fast-paced play combines laughs with realistic and dramatic issues faced by a couple in crisis.

The golf wife has to go extremes — including an affair with her

husband's caddy (Hamish Boyd) — to get her husband's attention.

Gates Wilson and Leigh create a convincing chemistry that carries them through both the light and serious scenes.

One of the biggest yuks comes at the beginning of the hour-long show, when Leigh and Boyd do their Broadway-esque golf dance.

Boyd's Caddy also helps move things along by rearranging the sparse set

between scenes, and at the same time sharing golf trivia.

The adult and modern themes in *Whole in One* create an adventurous and outgoing way to spend a lunch hour.
